The **5th Annual St. Patrick's Parade** will be on **Saturday, March 12th** at High Noon. The route will be the same as in years past, starting at the Arkansas River and then proceeding west along Douglas Avenue to Walnut Street.

As we've mentioned in past newsletters, the City is changing the rules for public events which will increase the expense of putting on parades and other events. To help offset costs we solicited sponsors and increased the entry fee to \$25.
